Dear Sir/Madam,

Following on from recent meetings with Wiltshire's Public Art Officer, Meril Morgan, and Warminster History Society and museum, we are contacting you regarding the public artwork for the new housing development by Redrow Homes at the end of Victoria Road near A36 and Warminster Rugby Football Club.

Our proposal is to create an intimate space within the wider Public Open Space Area of the development, which will provide a seating area, and have a central focal piece of artwork. We have submitted a discharge of condition application for the public art to Wiltshire Council. Wiltshire Council Public Art Officer and the Planning Officer have agreed to the installation of an armillary sundial as the central artwork. The armillary sundial will be commissioned specifically for the site by a specialist artist and will function in a number of different ways. The piece will function as an artwork, and a time piece within the space. As part of the armillary we are proposing to incorporate engraved wording that will link the piece back to its setting in terms of local historical, literary, or artistic connections. The sundial also has the capability of commemorating a locally contextual date.

We had a constructive meeting with Warminster History Society member on 13.02.2018. The Warminster History Society and museum have helped us to formulate the initial wording which relating to Warminster history and culture, and will form part of the focal piece.

We would like to invite you to inform the process alongside the Warminster History Society's input.

For information and to give the above suitable context, we have attached an example of an armillary sphere showing the piece as a whole and an example showing the wording upon the bands running around the outside of the sphere. If you would like to discuss the above or help to inform the wording, please do not hesitate to contact us.
