Devolved Services and Assets Sub-Committee: Thursday 23rd August 2018 Clerk's Report: Town Park and Associated Land Item 7

- a) Lake: the lake has been topped up regularly to ensure the oxygen levels are enough to sustain the wildlife.
- b) Pavilion Café: continues to trade well. It has hosted the recent MacMillan Cancer coffee event which was a great success. Ikea childrens' table and chairs have been installed.
- c) Skate park: a meeting will take place on 4th September. A background paper covering the history of the skate park and summarising the fundraising to date has been supplied by the Friends of Warminster Park and will be distributed to all members prior to the meeting.
- d) Putting green: noting to note.
- e) Park and central car park public conveniences: the interior door handle had worked loose in the central car park disabled toilet. A contractor has been appointed to repair.
- f) Tennis courts: the use of the tennis courts has increased this summer; all five courts have been used simultaneously at times. The refurbishment has been put on hold temporarily pending the outcome of the skatepark meeting.
- g) Boats on the lake: feedback has been good and there is a constant flow of trade. The last day of the season will be 9th September, Carnival Fun Day.
- h) MUGA area: nothing to note.
- i) The Boat House: nothing to note.
- j) Tree works: following the recent follow-up tree survey, reported to members at the last meeting, the priority 3 works have been quoted for, see attached, and will be actioned. The cost falls within the Clerk's spending limit. Members to note. T516 Oak, will be actioned in due course as it is not a priority.
- k) Green Flag: this has awarded for 2018.

T509 - Cockspur Thorn, remove stubs and dying branch £40.00 + VAT

T514 - Horse chestnut, dismantle and fell £550.00 + VAT

T516 - Oak, reduce/re-pollard at approx. 1.5 - 2 metres above the previous pruning points £1000.00 + VAT

T539A - Birch and Elm, dismantle and fell £450.00 + VAT

Re: Security Roller Shutters

Further to my visit to the Pavilion Café in Weymouth Street to inspect the existing shutters with a view to converting them from spring assisted manual pull down operation to electrical operation.

By removing the existing shutters and fitting new electrical shutters the final cost of the works is much clearer the new shutters will also be guaranteed against defect for a one-year period, conversions are classed as repairs and although the motors will be warranted anything other than this would not be covered under any warranty

One of the hoods was removed to inspect the condition of the mechanism, it was apparent that there were some broken end locks at the top of the curtain that would also need repairing as it is very important that these laths do not slide across and damage the electrical cables if the shutters are converted to electrical operation.

The process of converting the existing shutters to electrical operation although possible may not be a viable or best option as there is some wear and tear evident that will also need addressing as the job progresses with the final cost of this being unknown at the start of the works.

The existing shutters would require the barrels to be removed and the springs stripped out so it is more cost effective to fit new barrels, bearings, spindles and motors, the shutter that covers the main entry will also require a centrifugal safety brake fitted to the barrel to comply with current E.U. Health & Safety regulations.

Locks fitted to these shutters will be removed and locking hangers fitted to the top laths of each shutter.

The electrical wiring for each shutter would be taken back inside the café in surface mounted PVC trunking and a series of six wall mounted switches will be fitted to control the shutters from, the main entry shutter can be controlled by either an external key switch or a remote control for the same price.

It will be necessary to have electrical fused spurs supplied and fitted by others to allow us to make connections.

New Shutters

Removal of the existing shutters and fitting of new electrical operation shutters would be the better option as these will be manufactured to include everything required including safety brake, manual override facility integrated autolocking top laths, remote control to entry /exit shutter and will include warranty.

These new shutters are priced manufactured for German Heroal high quality aluminium materials with the shutter curtains manufactured from twin wall extruded aluminium materials, all finished in white paint finish.

These seven new electrical operation shutters will cost £11,857 or converting the existing will cost £8530

All prices are subject to final survey and exclude VAT that will be added at 20% Delivery at the moment is approximately 3-4 weeks from final survey
