8. Spring in the Park May 5th 2019

Spring in the Park 2018 was a high-profile event attracting thousands of people to the Lake Pleasure Grounds. Members are requested to appoint a Councillor to the Working Group organising Spring in the Park 2019.

9. Warminster Parking Partnership

Update from Cllr Robbins on efforts to recruit more shops to the scheme. It is noted that the Three Horseshoes walk are currently offering 3 hours free parking. Members are requested to suggest any other ways in which the WWP scheme can be promoted. It may be that more prominent signage would help. (see attached)

10. Gazebo



It has been suggested by officers that the Council could purchase a Gazebo branded with the Town Council Logo for use by Cllrs at events in the Lake Pleasure Grounds such as Spring in the Park and Inspire. The Gazebo would be sturdy and capable of use on grass or hard surfaces such as pavement and so suitable as a base or focal point for Litter picks and the Christmas Lights Switch on. Depending on the exact specification chosen and the nature of the branding, the cost is likely to be in the region of £750. (see attached) **Members are asked to consider if they wish the Council to go ahead with such a purchase.**
