Paul Trofimov, Development Consultant & Director of Ace Retirement (Warminster) Ltd confirmed that agreement had been reached to the change the age limit to 60.

Re-consultation on the change to the description of development (to include the reference to variation of condition 8 as well) and the suggested draft conditions only.

Variation of conditions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 29, 30, 31, 34 & 35 pursuant to planning application 17/05360/OUT (Continuing care retirement community (CCRC) comprising a 48 bed care home (Class C2), 46 extra care apartments and facilities (Class C2), 39 affordable extra care apartments and facilities (Class C2), 45 retirement bungalows/chalet bungalows (Class C3), medical centre and pharmacy, relocation of children's play area, recreational and flood compensation area and biodiversity protection/enhancement of County Wildlife Site, all with associated access roads, parking, infrastructure and raising of ground levels by 500mm (outline application relating to access and layout). Resubmission of 16/08425/OUT) to allow for phasing of the development.

(Previous submission sent to Wiltshire Council including comments attached for reference and further information about condition 8)

Members debated this application at some length. They felt that the developer had listened to the concerns that had been raised and compromises had been met.

Cllr Fryer proposed no objection to the plans subject to the following conditions:

- Reassurance that the age limit of condition 8 (a) is changed to "Persons of 60 years of age or over:"
- Retention of the assurance of provision of necessary infrastructure being completed prior to allocation of plots for separate sale.
- That remodelling of flood risks take place on modified software/data. (The model for the environment agency predictions have been found to be flawed, members do not wish the development to make the situation downstream worse.)
- As Members supported the application, they agreed that it was no longer necessary for application to be called in.

Seconded Cllr Nicklin, unanimous in favour.
