The Environmental Services Policies Working Group met online for the first time on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2020. Outlines of policies were discussed. #### 8. <u>Purchase of battery-operated equipment</u>

Quotations have been sought for battery operated equipment to enable the Park and Open Spaces team to carry out essential works 'in house' which fall outside any current contracts. The Parks and Open Spaces team demonstrated Husqvarna equipment and found this to be extremely good.



Three quotations were received for a Strimmer, Blower, Hedge-cutter and Chainsaw and associated batteries and chargers. The quotes received:

Lister Wilder	£1970.33
Leigh Park Garden Machinery	£2140.00

Officers felt purchasing from Melksham Groundcare Machinery would offer the best value for money. They are local, have assisted officers with demonstrations and are able to service and maintain the equipment. So far, the level of customer service received has been excellent.
