Full Council had referred to the committee, the recommendation by the Splashpad Working Group of six play panels to be installed along the fence adjacent to the splashpad and that work be undertaking to help preserve the retaining wall.

Six play panels should be installed along the fence by the splashpad. at a cost of approximately £6,000 plus VAT.

The small blue retaining wall by the splashpad to have the existing render removed, new render applied and painted with a coping stone installed on top. Funding for both items to come from the General reserves.
