# HC/24/011 Matters Arising from the meeting of the Local Highways and Footpath Improvement Group (LHFIG)

**HC/24/011.1** Members noted the updates from the LHFIG meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024. **HC/24/011.2** Members agreed the extent of the proposed 20mph zone viability study:

West Street to Co-op, Vicarage Street, along the Bath Road (Church Street) to Minster Church, Pound Street to the Maltings, George Street and Silver Street, Emwell Street and Sambourne Road (to the other side of the crossing by the beeches). This would be submitted with a highlighted plan to the LHFIG, as requested at the LHFIG meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024.
