038.1 St Andrews Road

HC/25/039 20mph town centre speed limit surveys

Members noted the town clerk has agreed to pay the Warminster Town Council minimum 25% contribution of £3,062 to the LHFIG for the implementation of the 20mph speed limit in Warminster.
