

Community grants scheme open

Warminster Town Council is continuing to support local voluntary organisations with the 2025 community grant applications now open. Each year the town council allocates budgeted funds to anything which, in the council's opinion, is in the interest of its area or part of its area, or in the interest of all or some of the inhabitants of that area. Only one grant per organisation may be given in any council year, which is limited to £2,500 per applicant. Read more here.



The popular splash pad in Warminster's Lake Pleasure Grounds is being enjoyed and has kick started a busy time for the park. The splash pad offers another fun free activity for visitors as well as the skate park, lava trail and play park. Tennis courts and pickleball courts are becoming increasingly popular. To book either a tennis or pickleball court you'll need to register with the LTA here and then book via Clubspark. Courts need to be booked online prior to arrival. Tennis, pickleball and golf equipment can be hired from the café during opening hours. Canoeing and rowing has also returned and available to hire during weekends and school holidays. The park will also host a large variety of events for all the family this year.



Warminster Town Council has installed new information boards at three key locations to welcome visitors to the town. The information boards represent another part of Warminster Town Council's wider commitment to maintaining pride and improving assets in the town.
